Bihar is effectively using IT to make the administration quick, responsive, transparent, hassle-free and accessible, while reducing the inefficiencies and costs.

The State is home to large number of educated and skilled young people. The level of digital literacy in today's youth in Bihar is very high. The Government of Bihar recognises the need of helping the IT industry grow so that the youth of the state have ample opportunities for finding suitable jobs.
